SIREN SONGS...Heather Bambrick: You'll Never Know

Canada's Heather Bambrick has an easy going voice that is filled with clarity on this collection of standards. The supporting team of Mark Kieswetter (piano), Ross MacIntyre (bass), Davide DiRenzo (drums), Rob Piltch (guitar), Chase Sanborn (trumpet / flugelhorn), John Johnson (sax), and Guido Basso (flugelhorn) works well as she sounds confessional on "You'll Never Know" and swinging easy on "I Only Have Eyes For You." She shows swagger as she gets sassy on the hip "Get Happy" and gets a bit Broadway-ish on the luminescent "Never Never Land" and "My Ship." Flexible and satisfying.
